



Perry Township Solid Waste RFB Amendment No. 1

PERRY TOWNSHIP, STARK COUNTY, OHIO

Date of Issuance: July 28, 2026

Notice is hereby given that the Perry Township, Stark County, Ohio has formally amended the Request for Bids (RFB) for residential waste and recycling collection services. All prospective bidders shall take note of the following modifications, clarifications, and additions. Bids submitted must reflect these revised terms.

Section I. Modifications to RFB Terms and Specifications

1. Section 2.3 and 6.36— Household Unit Count

- **Modification:** All bidders shall base their pricing and financial proposals on a standardized baseline of exactly 12,000 residential units, replacing the previous estimate of "just under 12,000 households" to ensure equal evaluation and fairness among competing bids.
Note: This unit count reflects the best estimate the Township could determine based on available data.

2. Section 6.5 and Legal Notice — Initial Contract Term and Renewals

- **Modification:** The initial term of the contract shall be modified to a 3-year initial term with two (2) optional 1-year renewal periods, providing stability and better pricing options.

3. Section 6.5 — Contract Commencement Date

- **Modification:** The official start date for the trash hauling contract is established as **180 days after the bid award**. This adjusted timeline provides adequate preparation time for bidders, thorough evaluation and scoring by the Township, and a smooth transition period for residents.

4. Section 6.37.B — Scope of Exclusive Service

- **Clarification:** While the selected hauler is granted an exclusive contract for the Township, mandatory participation shall not apply to all residents. Mandatory service is strictly limited to residential units comprising single-family homes, duplexes, triplexes, and quad-plexes located on public streets.

5. Section 6.40.L — Collection Containers

- **Clarification:** Requirements concerning the furnishing of specific containers—such as one (1) 96-gallon trash cart and one (1) 65-gallon recycling cart per residential unit—are designated and shall be priced under Section 6.12.D (Optional Items).

Section II. Bidding Scenarios

Bidders are required to submit pricing reflecting the following operational structures:

- **Scenario A (Opt-Out Model):** A 3-year initial term with two (2) 1-year renewals, wherein individual residents are permitted to opt out of the service by directly contacting the selected hauler. *This is a new scenario.*
- **Scenario B (Mandatory Model):** A 3-year initial term with two (2) 1-year renewals, wherein eligible residents (single-family through quad-plexes on public streets) are required to participate and use the selected hauler. *This is a new scenario.*
- **Scenario C (Opt-In Model):** A 3-year initial term with two (2) 1-year renewals, wherein individual residents will opt in by contacting the selected hauler directly. Please indicate what services would be included in this scenario. *This is a new scenario.*

Please note that Friday collection was only a suggestion and the township is open to other collections days as proposed in bids.

Section III. Updated Schedule and Deadlines

- **New Bidding Deadline:** Sealed bids must be received by the Township Administration office no later than **September 22, 2026, at 4:00 PM.**
- Bids will be opened and read aloud at the Board of Trustees Regular meeting on September 22, 2026, at 6:00 PM.
- **Contract Effective Date: 180 days after the bid award.**
