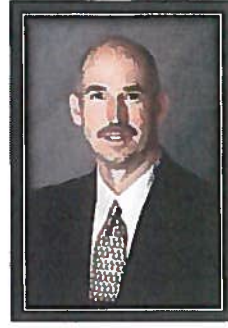

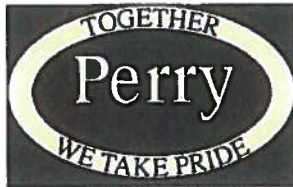
Ribbon Cutting Ceremonies . . .

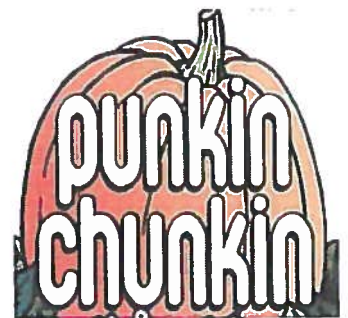

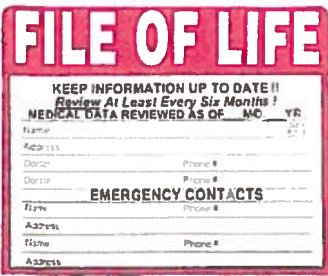

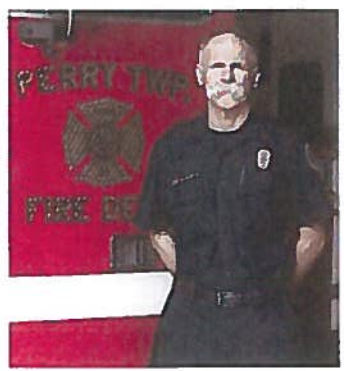

Perry Township Fire Department Importance of an Address Marker

Having an identifiable and easy to read address marker is critical for Public Safety Forces to respond to your emergency. There are numerous factors that hamper our ability to locate your structure; nighttime, fog, snow, address numbers painted on street curbs and non-reflective addresses mounted on house are just a few examples that make finding your structure difficult. Perry Township Fire Department through a Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) grant is offering **FREE reflective address markers** to all Perry Township residents. The reflective address markers are constructed using the latest reflective technology available. Requests for reflective address markers can be made by going to the Perry Township website at Perrytwp.com, click on "Departments", click on "Fire Department." On the Fire Department page under "Safety Resources" click on "Request Reflective Address Sign."

The Perry Township Zoning Resolution was adopted and voted on by residents on November 4, 1958. Perry Township has many zoning districts; they range from residential to Industrial. It is a good idea to know what zoning district your home is in and what district or districts surround your home. All it takes is a call to the Zoning

Department with your address.

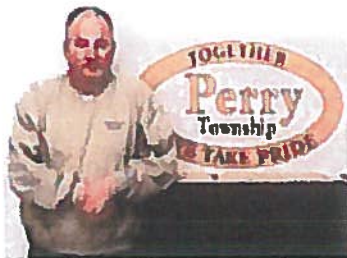
Department Updates

Grants for the Road Department 2017

The Perry Township Road department was awarded six grants for the year 2017. The first is: 4th St./Pleasant Hills Drainage Improvement, and will be funded by the Township and Ohio Public Works Commission. The first phase generally consists of the following:

- Construction of a detention basin at the northeast corner of the 4th St. N.W. and Ambrose Ave. N.W. intersection. Construction of curb and gutter along 4th St. N.W. from Ambrose Ave. N.W. to Manor Ave. N.W.

Community Development Block Grant funding for:

- 13th St. Sidewalk Improvements-\$45,000.00
- Perry Park Improvements-\$41,497.00
- Oak Hill Park Improvements-\$85,000.00

Diesel Emission Reduction Grant:

Replacing two aging trucks with very high emission standards with two new Class 5 utility diesel trucks. The Road Department applied for a \$112,615.40 grant, and was awarded 75% of the re-imbursement funds which came to \$84,461.55, along with a 25% match from the Township of \$28,153.85. The emissions savings shown in the Diesel Emissions Quantifier were 1.535 tons/year NOx and 0.043 tons/year PM 2.5.

2017 Program Startup Grant:

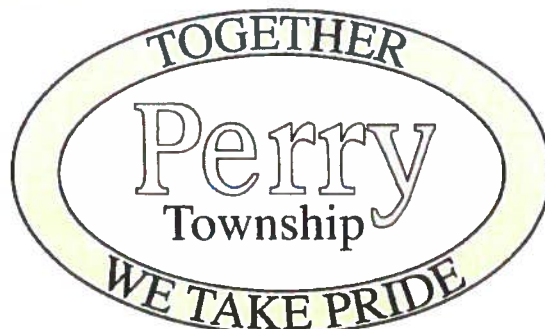
Improving our recycling site-The Road Department was awarded \$21,641.00 to pave 5,110 sq.ft. of our recycle site, along with surveillance cameras to better serve our residents. It requires no matching funds from the Township. Please watch for upcoming information on when this will take place.

There will also be a parade earlier in the day starting at 11 am at Perry Township Hall and the Cruise-In participants are most welcome to also join in the parade.

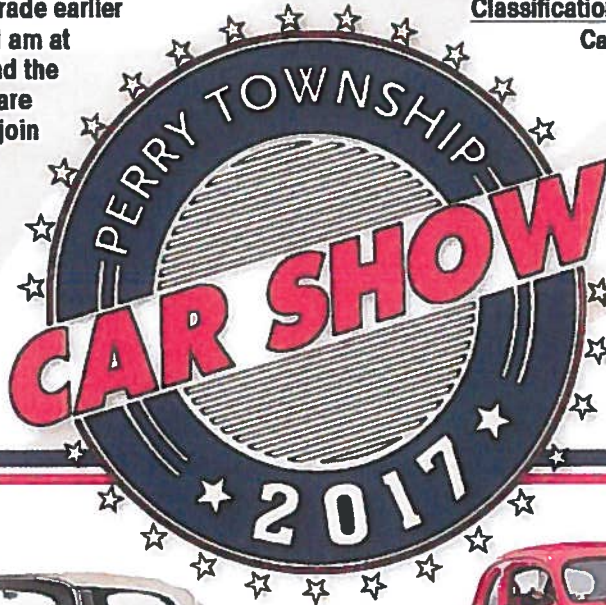
