Call Meeting to Order

Trustee Nelligan stated the special meeting of the Perry Township Board of Trustees is called to order at 5:00 pm.

Zoning Appeal request by Michele McQueen concerning property located at 3432 Lincoln Way E

Zoning Inspector Jeff Whytsell thanked Ms. McQueen for joining via video. She was unable to attend the meeting in person and appeared by tele-a-conference. Law Director Mathews stated as he understood the record that Ms. McQueen requested this hearing after receiving notice of a demo from the zoning department of the township. Law Director Mathews stated that state law does allow a hearing to consider the issue. He stated the easiest way to proceed will allow Ms. McQueen to provide any information for the Board to consider on whether or not to proceed with the demolition of the property. Michele McQueen discussed the property. She had a few questions. She asked if the township has the authority to take the property. All agreed to abate the nuisance via demolition of the property. Law Director Mathews explained the reasons and laws concerning the abatement to Ms. McQueen. She indicates the family has no problem with having the structure taken down. He explained the cost of this procedure to her. The Board felt the call went very well.
